Decision:

[1] This is a case where the complainant is no longer in contact with the Northwest Territories Human Rights Adjudication Panel (the "Panel").

[2] On January 23, 2017, the Panel issued a letter to the complainant to directing her to contact the Panel for a pre-hearing conference or risk possible dismissal of her complaint. The letter could not be delivered to the complainant's physical and e-mail addresses last known to the Panel, and the complainant did not contact the Panel.

[3] The Panel therefore issued a public hearing notice in two separate editions of each of the News North and the Hay River Hub. This was done to ensure the complainant has a last chance and opportunity to contact the Panel and pursue her complaint.

[4] The complainant did not contact the Panel or did not attend the scheduled hearing in person or by telephone. I consider the complaint abandoned and, as a result, the complaint is dismissed under Rule 32 of the Panel's Rules of Practice and Procedure.
